Arunachal Pradesh Teacher Eligibility Test (APTET) 2022 Successfully Conducted by SCERT, Itanagar on 02/02/2025

Itanagar, February 4, 2025 – The Arunachal Pradesh Teacher Eligibility Test (APTET) 2022 was successfully conducted by the State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT), Itanagar on 02/02/2025. The examination was held smoothly across the designated centers ensuring fair and transparent evaluation of aspiring teachers in the state.

APTET examination comprises of 02 (two) papers, Paper I for aspiring Primary Teachers (Classes 1 to 5) and Paper II for Upper Primary Teachers (Classes 6 to 8).

Earlier, the APTET was conducted by the Directorate of Elementary Education. However, with a strategic shift aimed at enhancing the quality and effectiveness of the examination process, SCERT, Itanagar, has been handed over the responsibility of conducting the prestigious eligibility test.

The APTET serves as a crucial benchmark for candidates aspiring to join the teaching profession in Arunachal Pradesh, ensuring that only qualified and competent individuals enter the education sector. The successful completion of the 2022 examination marks a significant step in streamlining the recruitment and selection process for teachers in the state.

In a commendable effort to expedite the evaluation process, the candidates were provided with the duplicate copy of their OMR answer sheet wherein they have recorded their responses. The candidates can also view the scanned copies of their OMR Answer sheet by login with the credentials they used during the time of registration.

The APTET 2022 result has been declared within 48 hours of the conduct of examination and candidates can view the result and the Answer Key in the websites <https://online.arunachaltet2022.in> or <https://scertarunachal.nic.in>

Out of 1797 candidates registered for Paper I, 1371 appeared and 244 candidates have passed with a pass percentage of 17.80%. And in Paper II, 2732 candidates were registered, 2230 appeared and 835 candidates have passed with a pass percentage of 37.44%

SCERT, Itanagar, extends its gratitude to all stakeholders, including candidates, examination staff and officials including magistrates & police personnel for their cooperation in ensuring the seamless execution of the examination.
